More about our program

Our summer camp focuses on Massaro Farm's mission to *Keep Farming, Feed People, and Build Community*. Campers will actively explore the 57 acres of farmland, fields, nature trail and wetlands.

We strive to reconnect children to where their food comes from by exploring our learning garden, through talking with our farmers, picking produce for their snacks, and even preparing for a farm stand! Campers will study the environment by hiking our nature trail, looking for signs of wildlife, listening for the sounds of nearby birds, and investigating the soil layers beneath them.

A typical day at camp involves crafts, snacks focused around a central theme for the day; growing plants, local wildlife, pollinators, and more. Our camp staff are all trained in first aid. We maintain a 1:8 staff to camper ratio.

What is Massaro Farm?

Massaro Community Farm is a 57-acre nonprofit organic vegetable farm. The farm grows 50+ varieties of vegetables, herbs and flowers, hosts workshops for youth and adults, and holds several community events each year. We donate at least 10% of what we grow to local hunger relief agencies. Donations have totaled more than 55,000 lbs since inception in 2010.
